**COVID-19 Risk and Mitigation Rules for the Tournament**

**We will be following the Sunshine Tour's COVID-19 Ready Guide document when organising and delivering all our tournaments. There are slight differences to adapt to the Sunshine Senior Tour document that will have different codes provided for the HealthDocs App for the different tournaments on the schedule.**

We urge all members/members caddies/amateur participants to download the HealthDocs App not less than 10 days prior to the event (June 07) and to follow the relevant procedures required for entry and playing acceptance. Please visit the GolfRSA website to familiarise yourselves with the governmental agreed regulations for play covering COVID-19.

The management of the Copperleaf Estate and Golf Club are obviously COVID-19 compliant with the requirements sent out by GolfRSA in line with Government Gazetted documentation. Members must sign in at the club and take a temperature test which must also be entered by the member in the HealthDocs Daily symptom log selecting the Fidelity Pro-Am as the place where the temperature screening was done. The Non-Pharmaceutical Interventions i.e. wearing of masks when not eating or drinking, physical distancing of >1,5 m and regular sanitisation in the club house and its immediate facilities must be strictly adhered to. Once on the course the wearing of masks is not necessary when physical distance of >3 m (> 5 m in windy conditions) can be maintained.

You will not be allowed to play or caddie unless your HealthDocs App is green for 10 consecutive days on the first day of the tournament and confirmed by the course/event compliance officer. The other alternative, should you not have 10 consecutive symptom free days, is to take an antigen test within 72 hours of the start of the event and produce this certificate to the compliance officer who will upload a photo of the certificate onto the HealthDocs Application after obtaining consent of the member concerned. You are required to complete the daily symptom log on HealthDocs after the test was taken and for the duration of the tournament.

**Draws:** There is a fixed draw

**Tee Times:** From 10.00am for the team groups in 4-balls in 10- minute intervals

**Carts:** Player's account. Sharing is possible at the players' risk. (Pros with Pros, Amateurs with Amateurs)

### Rules and Procedures - Risk Mitigation

1. On-line entry and payment to the Senior Tour; no payments will be taken at the course.
2. Entry fees are pre-paid to SAST by the professionals.
3. It is recommended you change to your golf shoes in the car park or club changerooms.
4. All carts will be fully sanitised daily by the facility.
5. **Range balls: The range at the top of the hill is available for practice free for players.**
6. Care should be taken not to handle unnecessary railings or items.
7. You may only go to the tee once the players in front have departed the teeing ground.
8. Score cards and additional local rules will be available at the first tee.
9. Halfway House food and soft drink is a 'grab and go' available after 9 holes.
10. All players need to observe and comply with physical distancing and sanitisation when playing.
11. All players/participants must wear masks off the course.
12. No bunker rakes will be provided; see local rules (placing within 1m from the original position)
13. Flag- Pole attendance is prohibited. The player/caddie may remove the flag stick with a glove/hand towel/flag stick material. There will be a travelling Sanitiser of the flag poles.
14. Only the player may retrieve and handle his golf ball at all stages.
15. No shaking of hands before or after play
16. Score cards must be smartphone photographed with the markers and player's names and scores.
17. Photos to be sent via WhatsApp to 083 227 0840 or 082 490 4027.
18. Amateur Players: may choose to play off a selected tee colour marker for handicapping purposes. All holes must then to be played off the same colour with club handicaps adjusted accordingly.
19. The professionals must play off the Senior Tour markers only.
