

Nic Henning wins at Sun City

Nic Henning, son of the late Graham Henning, and family of the world renown Henning clan, showed his pedigree and produced two solid under par rounds of golf (68 + 70) to win the Quatro sponsored Pro-Am event, held on the Lost City Course at the Sun City Resort from 23-24 August 2021.



The weather was on the fresh side on day two with some wind, but the golf course was in good shape for this time of the year with extremely fast and smooth greens.

While the starting field was not at full strength given that McNulty, Kingston, Horne, and Terblanche were either competing elsewhere in Europe or had other activities to attend, it was successful.

Nevertheless, a strong field of 26 professionals competed for the R22 500 first prize on offer alongside 78 amateur participants. Doug McGuigan made time to play in this tournament and finished second posting a level par score of 144. A day later he was off to play at Sishen in a Sunshine Tour event. Paul Marks (145) again showed his consistency finishing third and remained seventh on the 2021 order of merit and in line for the “Rookie of the year’ award.

The Senior Tour thanks the main sponsors of the event, namely Quatro, Heineken and Sun International, as well as all the amateur participants who contributed largely to the success of the tournament. The next event moves to Orkney from 1-3 October.
